

The Carolyn Nielsen Music Library is a membership service of the New Brunswick Choral Federation. It is designed to supplement, not to substitute for, a choir's own library and music purchases.

Borrowing privileges are a Membership benefit. Members may borrow only if membership dues and all library fines are paid.

Up to ten titles may be borrowed at any given time.

Choirs may borrow multiple copies of a title. Individual members may borrow single copies, but not multiple copies.

Mark in light pencil only. Damaged scores, including scores marked in pen or highlighter, must be replaced.

Borrowed music is subject to SOCAN/Entandem fees and all other applicable licences and royalties. These are the responsibility of the performing choir.

The borrower affirms that they understand their responsibility as it pertains to licensing borrowed music for performance, recording, and/or digital distribution.
